World Physiotherapy offers a support programme from June to 16 September 2024 for those with limited or no experience of submitting an abstract for a scientific congress. The goal of the World Physiotherapy support programme is to help the author present their material clearly and concisely prior to submitting the abstract to the formal abstract review process.

It is also a support programme for abstract submitters whose first language is not English, to help them with the language and format of their submission.

World Physiotherapy Congress 2025 takes place in Tokyo, 29-31 May 2025.

The congress programme committee (CPC) for World Physiotherapy is now recruiting potential supporters for authors seeking feedback on their draft abstracts.

It is important that World Physiotherapy recruits people with a range of research and topic interests that can be called on if required.

If you have participated or contributed to at least two World Physiotherapy congresses in the past and are interested in volunteering as an abstract supporter, please complete this questionnaire by 1 May 2024.


